The Person Centered Medicine International Journal, founded by prof. Giuseppe R. Brera in 2010, is the first journal on Person Centered Medicine to be born. It is an open access, peer reviewed journal addressed to scholars constituting a new editorial format for publishing and discussing theoretical and clinical innovation, medical education in Person Centered Medicine, research methods and health governance application of this new paradigm of medical science which antagonizes the mechanic, deterministic and epistemologically wrong bio-molecular one. Authors are invited to play an active role in the journal becoming member of the advisory board and the Person Centered Medicine International Academy. The PCMIJ for the first time promotes a new editorial organization with an educational and living structure addressed to create a direct relationship between authors, readers and members of the boards. Papers will be available on line on the journal website and printed in the PCMIJ Annals.

The Journal is the official organ of the Person Centered Medicine International Academy and the Milan School of Medicine of the University Ambrosiana where Person Centered Medicine is officially born and instituted in 1998 as educational structure in Medical Courses.
